Where	Do	you	work	in the evening?
How often	Do	your friends	live	near here?
What	do	Chris	play	tennis?
How much	do	your parents	live?	
	does	you	wash	your hair?
	does	this word	mean?	
	does	it	cost	to fly to Rome?

Questions with **always/usually/often**:

What	Do	you	always	have	breakfast?
	Does	Chris	often	play	tennis?
	do	you	usually	do	at weekends?

What do you do? = What's your job?:

- 'What do you do?' 'I work in a bank.'

do I/we/you/they ...
does he/she/it ...

- **Do they** like music?
- **Does he** like music?

D short answers

Yes,	I/we/you/they	do.
	he/she/it	does.
No,	I/we/you/they	don't.
	he/she/it	doesn't.

- 'Do your parents speak English?' 'Yes, they do.'
- 'Does George work hard?' 'Yes, he does.'
