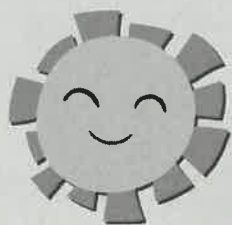


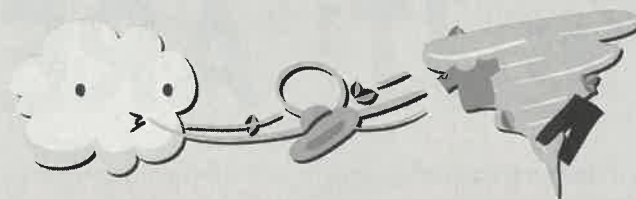
## TASK 1
